



Trips - Stone Age workshop, Science themed workshop, Colchester Castle, Library, Hacton Park.








### Assessments\_

No statutory assessments in Year 3.

Year 4 have the multiplication tables check.



The Multiplication Times Tables Check is an online test where the pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12. For every question, you have 6 seconds to answer, and in between the questions, there is a 3-second rest. Questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times table come up more often. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC.

### **Formal School Assessments**

- End of unit assessments in maths and foundation topics.
- Termly assessments in reading, spelling, punctuation and grammar and maths.
- Regular phonics screening for those working on the phonics programmes.









