Reception STAGE 2

You need to be able to:

Count to 50

Know your number bonds to 10

and...choose 4 activities from the list below:

Create a maths hunt in your local area or around your house that others will be able to follow

Make a picture out of 2D shapes and be able to name them

Make a list of at least 10 ways that you use maths in your everyday life – take photos Create a video of your own maths pattern

Create your own maths game, don't forget to include the rules!

Interview some of your friends /family and find out their views on maths – are they the same as yours?

Share your completed activities with your teacher and class. Your teacher will then let Miss Bain know and she will meet with you to have a chat and to give you your certificate and maths ambassador badge.
