## Hair styles, hair accessories, nail varnish, false nails and jewellery

No extreme hairstyles e.g. Mohawk, patterns shaved into hair, unnatural coloured hair dye.

Hair accessories must be blue or white. Hair bows should be no larger than 10cm.

Discreet stud earrings and a wristwatch (simple analogue or digital – no smart watches allowed) are the only items of jewellery that can be worn. Children cannot wear earrings or a watch for PE lessons and earrings cannot be taped so, if pupils are not able to remove their earrings, they will be found alternative involvement, such as a PE theory sheet.

False nails and nail varnish should not be worn.

#### **Religious items**

If amendments to this policy are required to allow individuals to wear religious items, these need to be discussed with the Headteacher in advance.

For health and safety reasons, items worn on the wrist that cannot be removed must be covered with a sweatband during PE lessons.

### Coats, book bags, water bottles and sun accessories

Suitable coat every day - warm for winter, light weight waterproof in warmer months

Branfil book bag\* (no other bags/rucksacks are allowed due to lack of storage space)

Water bottles, which must be: plastic, reusable, approximately 500ml capacity (so it will fit into our carry crates) and clearly labelled with child's name and class. Only plain water is allowed.

Sunhats and sunglasses can be worn when necessary (preferably in school colours). Sun cream must be applied before children come to school – it should not be brought into school.

## Swimming (Year 4 only)

Swimming costume (no bikinis or tankinis), trunks or shorts (no Bermuda shorts)

Swimming cap
