

# School Uniform: Years 1 – 6



Winter uniform	
Non PE days	PE days Children come into school wearing their PE kit
<p>White shirt/blouse/polo shirt</p> <p>Charcoal grey trousers or pinafore dress/skirt</p> <p>Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with* or without Branfil badge; no hoodies)</p> <p>White or grey socks/tights (no leggings)</p> <p>Black school shoes (no high heels or boots and must be suitable for running and climbing e.g good grip on sole, lace up or buckle fastening)</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>Black trainers (must have <b>black soles and no logos</b>)</p>	<p>Branfil blue T-shirt*</p> <p>Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with* or without Branfil badge) &amp; charcoal grey tracksuit bottoms</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>Royal blue Branfil hoodie* and tracksuit bottoms*</p> <p>White or grey socks</p> <p>Black trainers (must have <b>black soles and no logos</b>)</p> <p>Black plimsolls (for indoors)</p> <p>Long hair to be tied back</p>
Boots can be worn in the winter to travel to school, when necessary, then children must change into school shoes/trainers once they have arrived	
Summer uniform (optional)	
Non PE days	PE days Children come into school wearing their PE kit
<p>Charcoal grey tailored shorts</p> <p>Blue &amp; white check dress</p> <p>Black or white sandals (no flip flops, sling backs or peep toes for safety reasons)</p>	<p>Branfil blue PE shorts*</p>
Hair styles, hair accessories, nail varnish, false nails and jewellery	
<p>No extreme hairstyles e.g. Mohawk, patterns shaved into hair, unnatural coloured hair dye.</p> <p>Hair accessories must be blue or white. Hair bows should be no larger than 10cm.</p> <p>Discreet stud earrings and a wristwatch (simple analogue or digital – no smart watches allowed) are the only items of jewellery that can be worn. Children cannot wear earrings or a watch for PE lessons and earrings cannot be taped so, if pupils are not able to remove their earrings, they will be found alternative involvement, such as a PE theory sheet.</p> <p>False nails and nail varnish should not be worn.</p>	

Religious items
<p>If amendments to this policy are required to allow individuals to wear religious items, these need to be discussed with the Headteacher in advance.</p> <p>For health and safety reasons, items worn on the wrist that cannot be removed must be covered with a sweatband during PE lessons.</p>
Coats, book bags, water bottles and sun accessories
<p>Suitable coat every day - warm for winter, light weight waterproof in warmer months</p> <p>Branfil book bag* (no other bags/rucksacks are allowed due to lack of storage space)</p> <p>Water bottles, which must be: plastic, reusable, approximately 500ml capacity (so it will fit into our carry crates) and clearly labelled with child's name and class. Only plain water is allowed.</p> <p>Sunhats and sunglasses can be worn when necessary (preferably in school colours). Sun cream must be applied before children come to school – it should not be brought into school.</p>
Swimming (Year 4 only)
<p>Swimming costume (no bikinis or tankinis), trunks or shorts (no Bermuda shorts)</p> <p>Swimming cap</p> <p>Towel</p>
