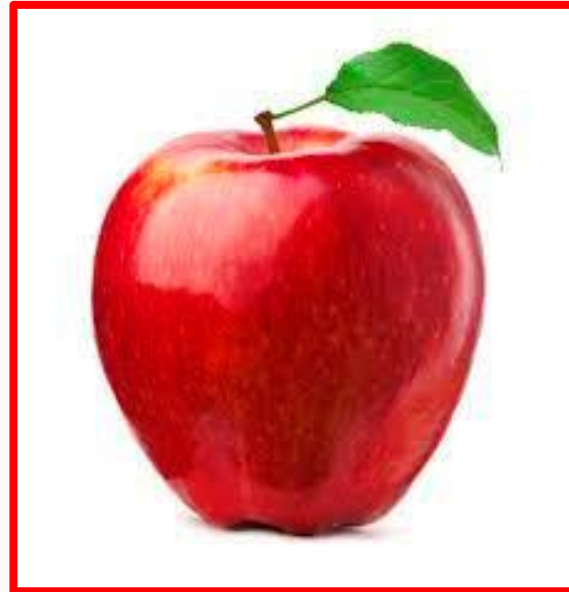

Uniform



- No extreme hairstyles - patterns shaved into the hair or unnatural coloured hair dye.
- Hair Accessories must be blue or white and hair bows no larger than 10 cm.
- Discreet stud earrings and a wristwatch (simple analogue or digital – no smartwatches allowed) are the only items of jewellery that can be worn.
- Children cannot wear earrings or a watch for PE lessons and earrings cannot be taped so, if pupils are not able to remove their earrings, they will be found alternative involvement, such as a PE theory sheet.
- False nails and nail varnish should not be worn.
- Water bottle must be plastic, not metal.
- Pencil cases - sensible size and no novelty items please.

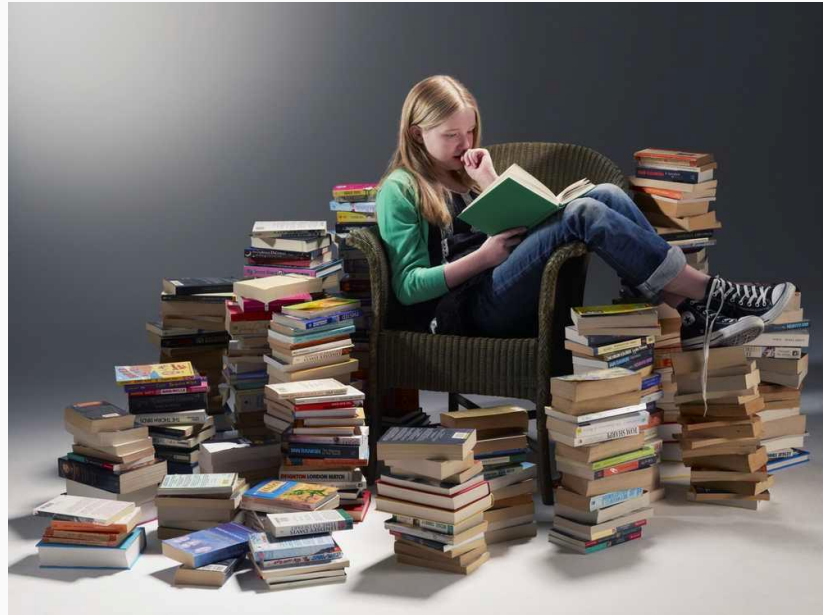

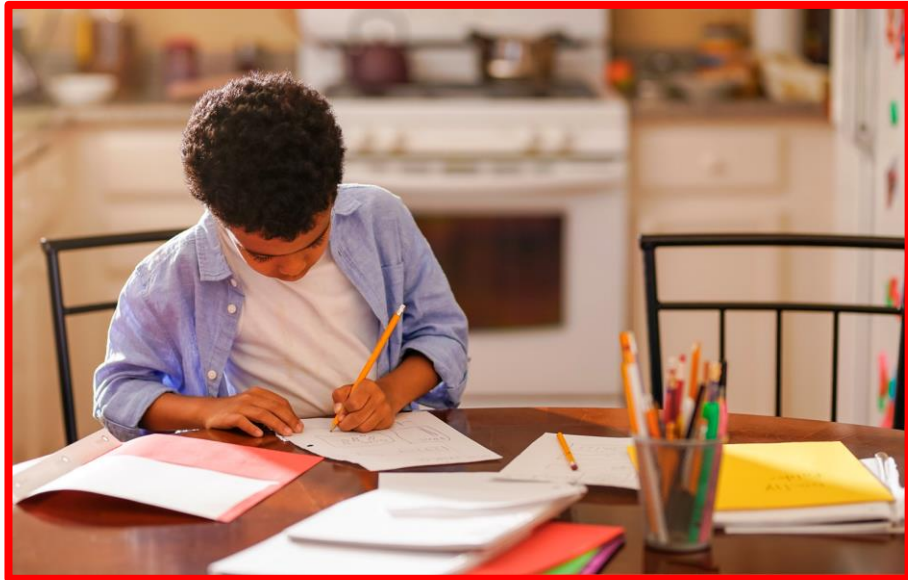
Spelling

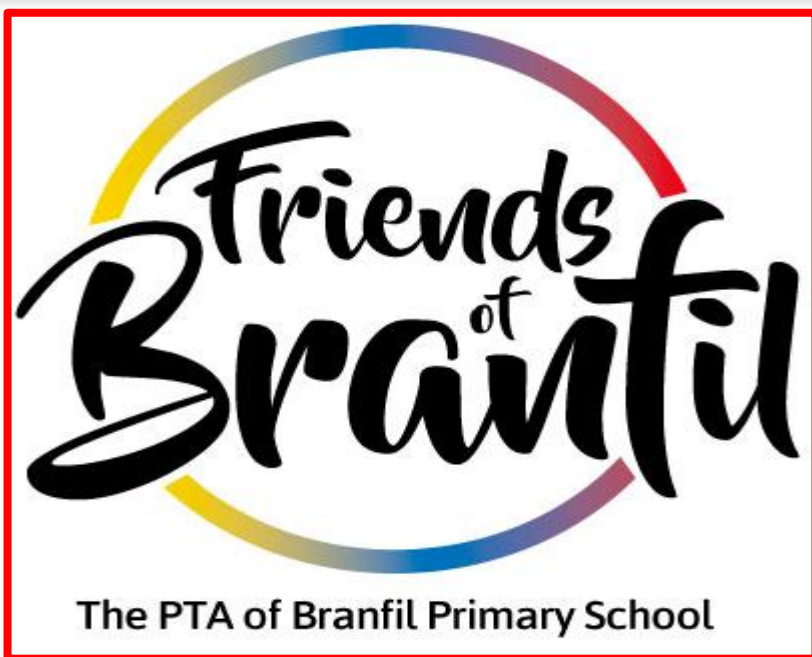
